The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Tom Valenta at 5:07pm

Topics and Actions:

1. The Board reviewed the Secretary's Report from the past meeting on 11/11/2025. A motion to approve the report was made by Bob Porter and seconded by Chad Lashinski. All were in favor and the motion carried.
2. The Treasurer's report was sent out via email prior to the meeting. A motion to approve the report was made by Chad Lashinski and seconded by Scott Dose. All were in favor and the motion carried. Monthly Bank statements for the last quarter were signed and approved by all members in attendance as per statutory requirements.
3. The board plans to revisit who we contract for Lake Weed Spraying in the late September - October timeframe trying to negotiate the best contract price and services for both the LID/POA and lake shore owners. Currently we are receiving a 10% discount from PLM for each individual lake shore owner. The MLLPOA also gives a 25% rebate to all members who contract service with PLM. A motion to move forward with contracting PLM for the 2026 year was made by Charlton Gildea and seconded by Scott Dose.
4. The board discussed identifying future projects and creating a punch-list for the 2027 calendar year. Two locations have been identified as potential large projects by Wright County Soil and Water. The Board is looking for one or two smaller project areas to also get on the slate for 2027. The Board will be working with Wright County and the Maple Lake Township to gather ideas and potential solutions to the identified projects areas. These projects will then be presented at the August 2026 Annual meeting for a special vote by members.

Chad Lashinski made a motion to adjourn and was seconded by Scott Dose at 6:04 pm.
